

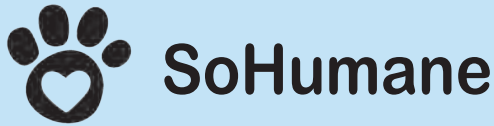

Unfortunately, we are seeing a bigger need from our community than ever before. Many people and pets are in desperate need of our help. Our Adoption Center is now open at noon every day, and staff are available to offer assistance.



Our expenses for providing special medical care for the dogs and cats continue to grow. SoHumane recently received an incredible gift for special medical needs from long-time supporters Jean Dunham and Maggie Honneger. We are thankful for their kindness and compassion and for the many generous donors who give so that treatable illnesses and veterinary conditions do not create barriers to an animal's adoption.

# Saving Lives - Special Veterinary Help

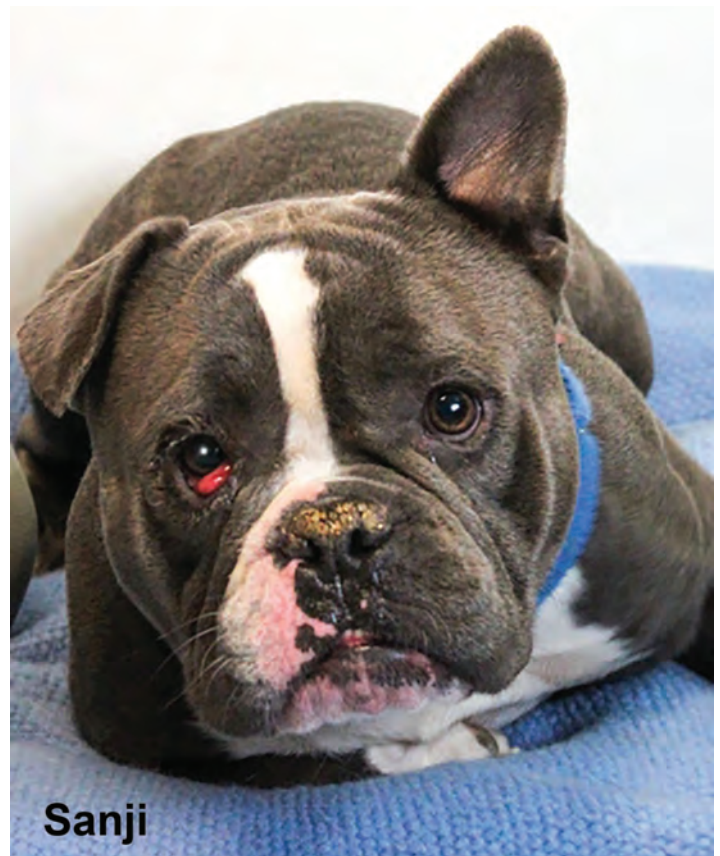

# The Value of Microchips

There is nothing that incites a feeling of panic like discovering your pet is lost or missing. Terrible thoughts enter your mind right away. Is he injured? Was she stolen? Will he be lost in the woods forever? It is a gut-wrenching, helpless feeling – a feeling I think we'd all do anything to avoid.

When it comes to missing or lost pets, one very helpful tool is a microchip. Prior to becoming a veterinarian, I questioned the value of microchips. Was it really necessary to permanently implant a foreign object under the skin of my pet? Decades and many experiences later, I now understand the immeasurable value of microchips.

Many pets, especially cats, were affected by the local and regional fires of 2020. Cats suffered burn injuries, including complete singeing of fur off of their bodies, and could only be identified by their microchip. And, there are dozens of stories online of dogs missing for years and over hundreds of miles finally reunited with their families – all thanks to a microchip.

Microchips are electronic chips about the size of a grain of rice enclosed in a tiny glass cylinder. Placed under the skin between the shoulder blades, a microchip is injected through a needle that is slightly larger than those used for vaccinations. No anesthesia or sedation is required for the injection. Microchips are often placed during regular veterinary office visits. A microchip itself does not transmit information. Instead, it acts as a transponder when activated by a microchip scanner. When a scanner is passed over a microchip, the chip transmits its unique identification number to the scanner.

Veterinary offices and animal shelters have microchip scanners. It is a common occurrence in a veterinary practice to scan stray dogs or cats

brought in by good Samaritans. Additionally, it is the first thing we do at SoHumane upon being presented with a stray dog or cat. If a microchip number is found it can be entered into a search database and after a few steps contact can be made with the pet's owner on record.

Microchips do not need yearly maintenance and many do not require yearly fees. To be functional, microchips must be registered! Then, as long as contact information for the pet owner is kept up-to-date with the microchip registry company, it will continue to trace back to the owner through scanning. However, the duty falls on the pet owner to ensure information is kept up to date. In addition, it is a good idea to have your veterinarian scan the microchip at least annually to ensure it is still functioning properly.



There are limitations to microchips. They do not carry information specific to your pet's health, nor can they be used to GPS track your pet while it is lost. For these reasons, a good old-fashioned pet collar with identification and rabies tags is still recommended.

Every dog or cat that is adopted from SoHumane receives a microchip. If you have a dog or cat that did not come from SoHumane, I would encourage you to investigate whether or not they have a microchip. If not, contact your veterinarian and have your pet chipped. It just might save their life.

Boss is a good dog, lots of energy, but a bit stubborn as Terriers tend to be. He has gained some weight, too. – Glenn & Pam

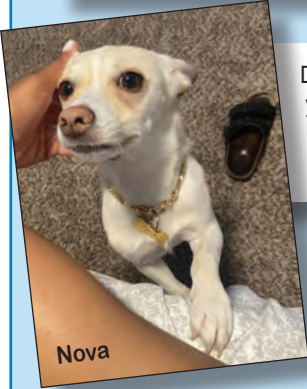
