

ummer has been an incredibly busy time for the staff and volunteers at SoHumane. We've already found loving homes for over 700 dogs, puppies, cats, and kittens. However, we are currently overwhelmed with an influx of stray pets, as well as an exceptionally high number of puppies and kittens.



In June alone, we had 126 kittens in foster care.

Our expenses for providing special veterinary care to our dogs and cats continue to grow. Many of the pets that come to SoHumane are in desperate need of medical and dental care. They are often in so much pain with dental disease that it is difficult for them to eat. We are deeply grateful for the kindness and compassion of you, our generous donors, whose support ensures that treatable illnesses and veterinary conditions do not stand in the way of an animal's adoption.

Unfortunately, the needs of our community continue to grow as well. Many people and their pets are in desperate need of assistance. Since its inception in 2020, our pet food pantry has provided over 6,000 pounds of pet food to individuals facing hardship in our community. In addition, we've distributed essential supplies like dog and cat crates and coats. Our goal in establishing the pet food pantry was to help community members keep their beloved pets by easing the financial burden of providing nutritous food, thereby reducing the need for surrendering to a shelter.

At SoHumane, we believe that every pet deserves a loving family, and we consider it an honor to help the pets that need us the most. Together, we are creating a better future for dogs and cats in need of homes, but we face many challenges. We must meet these challenges with empathy and determination. On behalf of everyone at SoHumane, and especially the dogs and cats touched by your kindness, thank you for making this meaningful work possible.





Over the years, we shared many heartfelt conversations about the importance of the lifesaving work we do. Jed was always there with solid advice and encouraging words. Our organization has been forever changed by their kindness and generosity. There are few words to express the deep sorrow of losing him, and he will truly never be forgotten.

Special Veterinary Care at SoHumane

For staff and volunteers at SoHumane, the days can be filled with emotion - some are rough, while others are full of joy. The good days definitely outweigh the tougher ones. We have the privilege of working for an organization that has the capacity to help dogs and cats with special veterinary needs. Many of

SoHumane has accepted animals surrendered to local veterinary clinics because their owners could not afford expensive treatment options. Injured dogs or cats brought in by good Samaritans to local veterinarians have also made their way to us, often with painful or disfiguring conditions. In addition, SoHumane has accepted animals from other animal welfare organizations that did not have the resources to address their specific medical problems.



For example, SoHumane has treated fractured limbs, blind or painful eyes, torn cruciate ligaments, severe dental disease, cancerous tumors, congenital heart defects, neurological conditions, heartworm disease, limb deformities, and late-stage pregnancies. The list of treatable conditions is extensive.

SoHumane strongly believes in giving dogs and cats in our care all the time they need to

ultimately be adopted. This, coupled with our generous and vibrant volunteer foster base, is a big reason we can take on animals with more advanced health issues. Many times, these dogs or cats will go into foster care for weeks to months. They need time to heal, and a foster home is a more stable place to recover than a shelter environment.

It would be remiss to not mention the veterinary partners that help SoHumane assess and address these often complicated medical issues. SoHumane is fortunate to have wonderful relationships with general practice veterinarians and specialty referral practices. They perform treatments and procedures outside the scope of our veterinary care. And perhaps most importantly, generous donations from SoHumane supporters make this specialized veterinary assistance possible.

What happens after a dog or cat heals? They are free of a major barrier to adoption - free of a painful, debilitating or potentially fatal condition. They have a new lease on life! And those of us working at SoHumane can notch another joyful day on our calendars.





Your gifts save lives every day.

Bunny arrived on the Saving Train from an overcrowded shelter in Northern California. She was days away from being euthanized. That evening she gave birth to a litter of puppies in a manager's office at SoHumane. Staff stayed late in the evening to help birth her eight puppies! 

OHumane finds homes for more than 1,200 ogs and cats each year. Volunteers help make providing exceptional care possible for these pets.

Dog walkers and the cat crew supply enrichment opportunities and exercise animals every day.

Student volunteers participate in Pet Partners, the PALS Program and the Reading Program.

Adoption and event volunteers are the support team for monthly and annual activities.

Foster volunteers provide a temporary home for dogs and cats that need veterinary treatment, a shelter break or time to grow before adoption.

itten fostering makes up the bulk of SoHumane's fostering needs. Kitten season brings hundreds of kittens. Many of these kittens are under eight weeks of age and require placement in foster homes. Foster families that nurture kittens allow SoHumane to save hundreds of kittens every year!

Foster volunteers provide a temporary home environment for kittens, puppies, dogs and cats that need a shelter break, time to grow before adoption, are receiving specialized veterinary care, or who are healing after surgeries.
