# When a dog arrives at SoHumane

**H**ave you ever wondered what goes on behind the scenes once a dog or cat arrives at SoHumane? A Saving Train run might bring anywhere from fewer than ten dogs and cats to more than 50 dogs to SoHumane at one time. The Saving Train travels as far away as central California to rescue animals in need. Merida

arrived with a group of dogs and kittens rescued this past winter.

Dogs like Merida that have been transferred on the Saving Train are weighed and are given parasite preventative immediately upon arrival at SoHumane. After that, they are settled into their kennels, either alone or with another dog. Dogs that have traveled a long distance are allowed from 48 to 72 hours to rest prior to progressing through further intake procedures. A dog is given time to adjust to new surroundings, calm down from the stress and excitement of travel, and become familiar with SoHumane routines. This allows volunteers and staff to learn the needs and quirks of each individual dog. The information-gathering period is crucial as it affords the gathering of details that will allow the dog to be successfully placed with an adoptive family.

Once the settling period ends, a dog goes through two intake procedures, typically on the same day. The initial intake allows staff to review medical information from the origin shelter for the dog, establish a database record, solidify a name, fit an identifying tag, and take photos. After that, the dog will undergo medical intake.

During medical intake, veterinary assistant staff examine the dog, assessing for any physical abnormalities or issues of concern.

Body temperature is recorded, and a microchip is placed if the dog does not already have one. Eyes, ears, skin and nails are evaluated, any sign of external parasites is recorded for treatment, teeth







are examined, and any signs of infectious disease are noted. Prophylactic parasite prevention is continued, vaccines are administered as needed, flea and tick control is started and any routine medications that are necessary are continued or started. Physical exam abnormalities are recorded and forwarded to the veterinarian.

If the dog is already spayed or neutered, any concerns will be addressed during an exam with the veterinarian. If the dog still needs to be spayed or neutered and physical exam concerns are not urgent, the veterinarian will thoroughly examine the animal immediately prior to the spay or neuter procedure.

Some dogs and cats may have an illness or injury that cannot be evaluated or treated at SoHumane. These pets are taken to vets in the community for x-rays, fracture repairs, dental assessments and cleanings, or other advanced diagnostics or treatments. SoHumane is grateful to work with a number of private practice veterinary clinics and veterinarians that are willing to help with these special cases.

After the intake procedures are done, a dog or cat is generally made available for adoption.





Their picture is added to the Adopt section of the SoHumane website, and appointments may be made by the general public to come and meet the pet if they seem an appropriate fit for an interested family.

Dogs and cats are not always spayed or neutered by the time they are made available for adoption. Spay and neuter surgeries are done each week. While an animal is under anesthesia for surgery they will also have their ears checked, nails trimmed and teeth re-assessed. These things are significantly easier to do in an anesthetized animal!

Depending on how many dogs and cats are awaiting spay/neuter surgery, surgery may be scheduled after their adoption. If so, they are released to their new families the day after their surgery is complete.

SoHumane staff and volunteers provide exceptional care for waiting dogs and cats until the happy day they are chosen by their forever family! We are privileged to be part of an organization where "saving lives" is what we do each day. This gift of life is only possible because of you, our amazing supporters. Thank you for helping make our dreams for the animals possible.
