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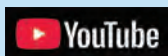

Saving Lives

Every day SoHumane receives requests for help from people and shelters desperate to save animals.

For twenty years SoHumane staff and volunteers have made frequent trips to shelters, driving hundreds of miles to bring dogs who were at death's door due to time and space limitations to SoHumane.

Since 2010 Southern Oregon Subaru has been sponsoring life-saving Saving Train rescues. They help raise the funds needed to transport dogs facing euthanasia or who have untreated medical conditions. At SoHumane they will never again face the life-threatening limitations of time, space, or veterinary needs.

Southern Oregon Subaru is the Presenting Sponsor for SoHumane's A Toast for Tails auction event this October. They sponsor the weekly KOB-TV NBC 5 Pet Talk where a dog or cat at SoHumane is featured.

Kitten season brings hundreds of kittens to SoHumane each year. Some arrive with the mother cat and others are alone or with litter mates. Many of the kittens are under eight weeks of age and require placement in foster homes to grow. The very tiny kittens may be bottle babies who need round the clock care. Foster families that nurture young kittens allow SoHumane to save hundreds of kittens every year!



Foster volunteers provide a temporary home environment for kittens, puppies, dogs and cats that need a shelter break, time to grow before adoption, are receiving specialized veterinary care, or who are healing after surgeries.

Foster homes are always needed!

Pride in Craftmanship

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Providing Exceptional Veterinary Care at SoHumane

SoHumane staff and volunteers are privileged to be part of an organization where “saving lives” is what we do each day. Often we are called to help dogs and cats with special veterinary needs. For example, SoHumane has treated fractured limbs, blind or painful eyes, torn cruciate ligaments, severe dental disease, cancerous tumors, congenital heart defects, neurological conditions, heartworm disease, limb deformities, and late-stage or complicated pregnancies.

Stormy was surrendered to SoHumane as a four-year-old intact female cat. Her owners could no longer provide appropriate care for her. SoHumane noted a severe heart murmur, atypical for a cat of Stormy's age. Her prior veterinarian confirmed that Stormy had a long-standing heart murmur, present since she was a kitten.

Arrangements were made for Stormy to undergo a consultation with the OSU Carlson College of Veterinary Medicine Cardiology Service. She underwent an ultrasound study of her heart and was diagnosed with a rare, complex congenital heart condition known as Tetralogy of Fallot.

Like all of the cats and dogs at SoHumane, Stormy deserves all that life can give her! For her best chance of living in a loving home she needed to undergo a spay procedure. A safe anesthetic plan was developed for Stormy's surgery, and she made it through with flying colors! Her heart condition will require regular veterinary visits, but now a home and family are part of her future.



Seven-year-old Rowley's intake exam revealed that he had dental disease, skin and ear infections, multiple masses, and signs of breathing difficulties. He was very thin and not neutered. Brachycephalic obstructive airway syndrome (BOAS) is a group of upper airway problems in flat-faced pets like Rowley. A compressed skull and soft tissues crowd the nose and throat, causing heavy breathing, snoring, and trouble cooling down. At SoHumane Rowley had surgery for BOAS and was neutered. Now adopted, he is living his happily-ever-after life.

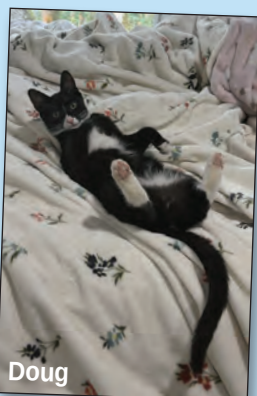

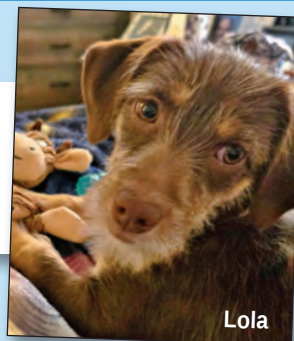
Bear Bear is the sweetest and very cuddly. He welcomes guests with a snuggle and wagging tail. He minds well and has adapted to training sessions very well.

Lola (Cookie) loves her new name. She answers to it very well. She is loved by my husband and me. Thank you so much.

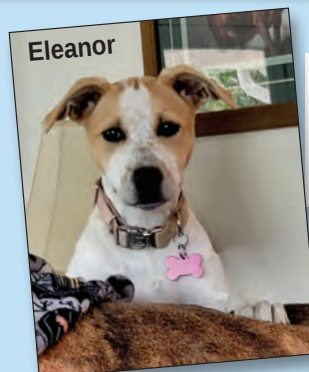


Junea (Athena) has fit in with our family perfectly. She is loving running

Bell is a shy love bug. She chirps and has the cutest high pitched meow. She also loves looking out the window at the birds.

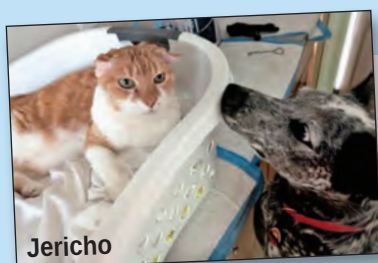


Eleanor is doing great. She likes to eat sticks and brings me trash she finds on the dirt around our place.

Wally (Pickles), is a very smart boy. He loves to play chase, tug, and take walks with his bestie our daughter. He loves his family.



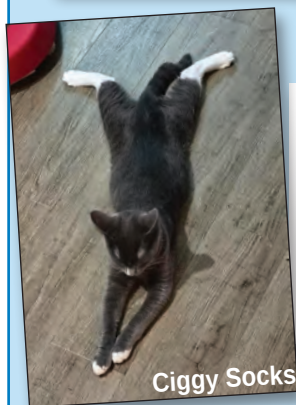
Kitty

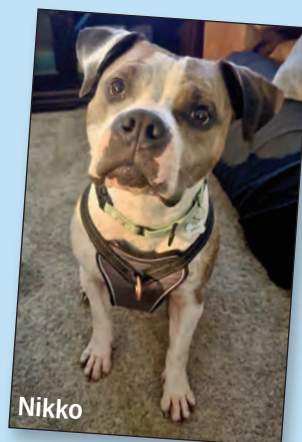
Mister Mo
