Animal shelters across the country are facing a crisis this year. 100,000 more shelter pets are at-risk of being euthanized now versus last year due to issues caused by the pandemic. SoHumane is no exception.



We are seeing a dramatic increase in people surrendering their pets due to economic issues, and we are being contacted daily with pleas for help from overcrowded shelters. Our community pet food pantry has already given 875 pounds of food to pets in need. That's 200 pounds more than this time last year.

Homeless pets arrive at our campus unwanted, abandoned, and neglected. Thanks to your support, when they arrive at SoHumane they receive all of the love, time and veterinary care they need to recover from their difficult journeys and prove that every animal is a life worth saving.

Although we are making a difference in our community and beyond there is still much work to do. Hundreds of pets are being euthanized every day across the United States. During difficult times pets can be a source of comfort. Now is the perfect time to add a new pet to your home. Please consider adopting a homeless dog or cat.

Together we will make a huge difference for deserving animals who simply need a second chance. We can ensure all pets, including those with special needs, have a safe and warm place to call home.

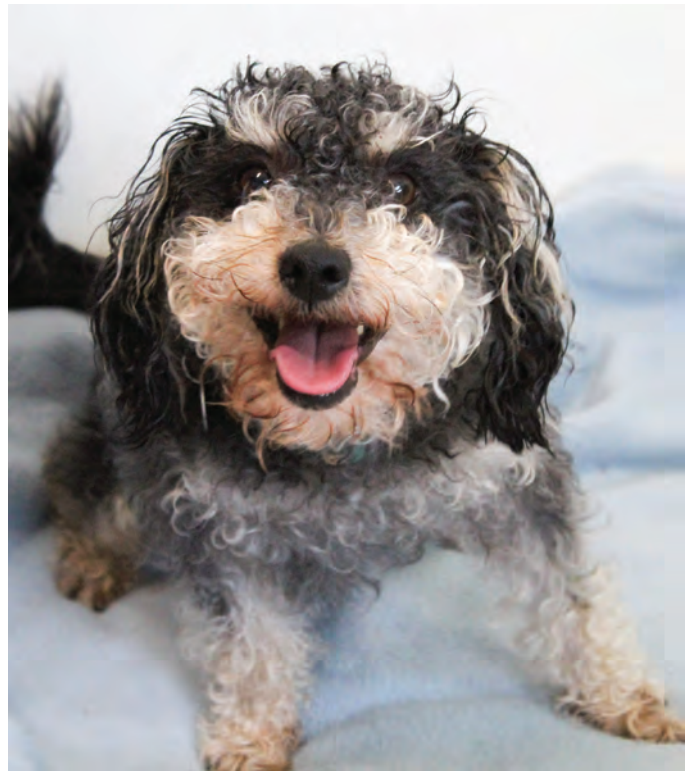

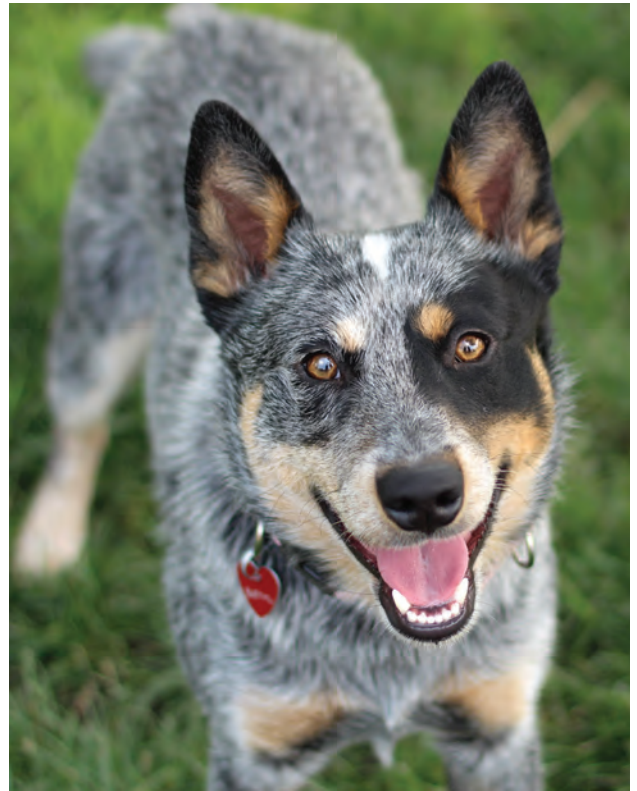

Emergency Vet Care

As we close the door on another busy summer season, we enter the relative routine of autumn: kids back in school, more time at home, and preparation for the upcoming holiday season. But here's something that doesn't follow a seasonal calendar: pet emergencies.

With the current unprecedented demand for veterinary care, it is often difficult to secure an appointment for your pet for his or her general wellness care, much less for emergency needs. Veterinary hospitals nationwide continue to struggle with staffing shortages and supply chain delays. Many general veterinary practices are no longer open on the weekend, further straining capacity during the week and causing overwhelming need at veterinary emergency clinics after hours. The wait for emergency care can last hours, and sometimes veterinary emergency facilities are forced to turn patients away if the pet's emergency is not deemed life threatening.

Despite the closest attention and best intentions of any pet owner, veterinary emergencies still occur. A little knowledge can go a long way in determining whether you should seek urgent veterinary care.

The following is a list of true veterinary medical emergencies for which immediate care is needed. Please note - this list is not all inclusive.

- Hit by car or gunshot wound
- Attack by another animal
- Difficulty breathing
- Heavy bleeding
- Heatstroke

- Acute collapse
- Continuous seizures
- Eye injuries or sudden blindness
- Vomiting or diarrhea that does not stop or includes blood
- Distended or bloated abdomen
- Inability to urinate, especially male cats
- Ingestion of poison or toxin
- Inappropriate mental status (inability to rouse, staggering, or comatose)
- Broken bones
- Severe hives
- Inability to deliver puppies or kittens in a timely fashion

When a veterinary emergency occurs, immediately call your family veterinarian, the local veterinary emergency hospital or a pet poison hotline. Have contact information for these facilities at hand so you don't have to waste time during a crisis.

There are ways to guard against veterinary emergencies. An annual examination for your pet helps ensure they are the healthiest they can be, and can often find subtle changes in their health that may make them more likely to experience an emergency. Keeping cats indoors and dogs leashed when outside will greatly increase the likelihood of your pet staying healthy. Never leave animals in a car when the outside temperature is above 70 degrees. Vehicles can become dangerously hot in minutes, even with the windows open. Be familiar with common substances that can poison pets (certain foods, medications, household cleaners, etc.) and ensure that your yard and home are free of such temptations.

Emergencies come out of nowhere. But with a little knowledge and preparation, they may be less stressful for all involved and lead to a happier outcome for you and your pet.

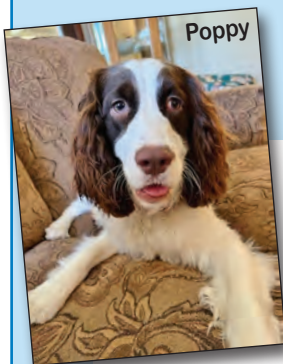

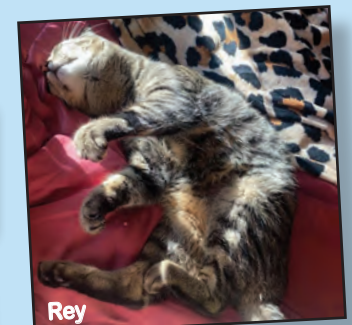
