It looks like spring has officially sprung and thanks to you 2019 is off to a great start for the dogs and cats at SoHumane. I can see our dedicated volunteers walking dogs from my window and soaking up the sun.

Recently we had 47 dogs arrive on the Saving Train for an adoption event and within two days 36 pets were adopted in their loving new homes.

One of our goals this year is to buy a larger Saving Train van so we can save even more precious lives. We were honored by the

Autzen Foundation who made the first gift of \$10,000 toward the purchase of the new van and have a visit scheduled with another foundation who is also considering a gift.

Our current Saving Train van only holds about 25 pets so we have to rent a van for a large trip and that costs about \$1,000 each time. We need \$35,000 to purchase the van, and there will be additional expenses to modify it to ensure the safety and comfort of the pets we are transporting. Wish us luck!

We are also busy making plans for our annual fundraiser, **A Toast for Tails!** I hope you have your tickets, because we have another exciting evening planned including a Game of Thrones-themed trip to Ireland! The event is on Saturday, May 18th. See you there!

Each year we aspire to save more lives, do more spay/neuter surgeries, help more pets with special medical needs and provide humane education and volunteer opportunities to the youth in our community. We could not accomplish this without our generous supporters, volunteers and foster families. We are truly grateful for the opportunity to help make the world a better place for the animals.

SoHumane Youth Programs

The Southern Oregon Humane Society provides daily opportunities for the youth of Southern Oregon to learn empathy, compassion and respect for all living creatures.

SoHumane's youth volunteer and school programs, shelter tours, and camps target elementary through high school students. Participants learn about our organization, our adoption program, and how we help animals and the people who love them. Many children and teens have the opportunity to learn from SoHumane staff and adult volunteers and interact with the dogs and cats in our care. Some choose to do scouting, community service and school projects that benefit the animals.

Humane education projects are available year round. The SoHumane summer camp program, for example, is designed to give younger children some of the skills and knowledge necessary to properly care for family pets and to help instill a lifelong sense of compassion and respect for all living things. Participants might learn the basics of responsible pet care, humane treatment of animals, dog safety, how to read body language and the importance of spaying and neutering.



SoHumane partners with college level students on a one to one basis by being a resource for class and capstone projects and internships.

By providing young people with positive animal interactions and the knowledge of how to properly care for dogs and cats, SoHumane's programs not only empower children to treat animals with love and respect but also to become thoughtful, empathetic and civic-minded citizens.



Too Many Kittens - You Can Help

Kittens and puppies! The things of children's dreams!

Tt's difficult to acknowledge that a society could ever have too many soft, fluffy, adorable kittens or puppies. But most of the world has just that - an overpopulation of dogs and cats. In 2017, the ASPCA (American

Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals) released national shelter estimates showing that despite improvements in euthanasia numbers, 1.5 million cats and dogs are still euthanized in shelters every year.

Our community cannot claim to be exempt from pet overpopulation, especially with regard to cats. We may feel we live in a responsible society where we and most of those we know believe in spay and neuter programs. But with the arrival of spring comes kitten season in Southern Oregon, and proof will be right in front of our eyes that cat population control is a major issue for this region.

Let's look at some quick facts of cat reproduction. Did you know that a female cat can:

- Become pregnant as young as 4 months of age
- Go into heat every month from spring through fall
- Become pregnant even before completing weaning of her most recent litter

Although estimates of cat reproduction abilities are controversial and often overestimated, a relatively realistic and conservative computation based on reproduction and survival statistics illustrates that a single cat may produce as many as 49,000 surviving offspring in 10 years! That number boggles the mind.

At SoHumane, the veterinary care staff and kitten fosters spend a good portion of the spring, summer and fall caring for kittens surrendered

to us from the community. These kittens range from days-old babies to kittens old and big enough for spay and neuter surgeries. Extensive care is necessary for days-old kittens, which are immediately sent to foster care as bottle babies. Once kittens reach eight weeks of age and a minimum of two pounds, they are ready to be placed up for adoption and can undergo their spay or neuter surgery.



In addition to taking care of hundreds of kittens that will turn into pets each year, in 2018 SoHumane, in partnership with SNYP (Spay/ Neuter Your Pet), piloted a trap/neuter/release program for feral cats. Feral or community cats are unowned cats that live outdoors and are not socialized or friendly to humans. These cats live in colonies and generally survive outdoors on their own but are often assisted by generous humans who visit the colony daily to provide food. Southern Oregon is home to dozens and dozens of feral cat colonies. SoHumane continues work on feral cat trap/neuter/release programs to address cat overpopulation issues.

What can YOU do to help cats and kittens in YOUR community?

- Ensure that every cat you make a part of your family is spayed or neutered.
- Ensure that stray cats you may feed are also fixed. If you have feral cats that roam your property, look into trap/neuter/ release programs.

- Do not think that letting your cat have just one litter is a good idea. Even though you may find homes for those six kittens to which your cat gives birth, it still takes those homes away from six other homeless cats.
- Don't buy kittens or cats from breeders adopt, don't shop!
- Donate to local rescue organizations.
- Volunteer as a kitten foster. SoHumane is always in need of families willing to care for kittens until they are old enough to be in the adoption program.


If everyone takes steps to overcome cat overpopulation issues in our community, perhaps the euthanasia of unwanted or homeless cats in shelters across the nation will become a thing of the past.




