The Invaluable Help of Volunteers

Volunteers make the world go 'round at the Southern Oregon Humane Society. From Saving Train transport drivers to event volunteers, from kitten fosters to dog walkers, SoHumane could not do what it does or be the successful organization it is without the invaluable help of hundreds of volunteers.

You may not know, but on the vet care side of things at SoHumane, we rely strongly on volunteers. The veterinary care staff at SoHumane is a small group, composed of part time veterinarians and vet care staff. For the over 1,500 dogs and cats cared for each year – seven days a week – that is a pretty small staff. Volunteer help is extremely important.

At the Southern Oregon Humane Society, vet care volunteers have more freedom to learn than might be found in a private veterinary practice. Vet care volunteers may be working towards a career in the veterinary field. They are frequently pursuing formal training as a vet assistant or technician in a certified program. Everything a volunteer does is directly supervised by a veterinarian or a trained member of the SoHumane vet care staff.

As a vet care volunteer or intern, initial training revolves around animal restraint and handling. From there, an intern learns the medical intake procedure completed on each dog and cat at SoHumane. This involves becoming familiar with parasite and vaccination protocols and learning physical exam and behavior assessment skills. The highlight for most interns is spending time assisting with surgery preparation and watching surgical procedures. Although not for everyone, this seems to be the icing on the cake!

As a veterinarian, I find that teaching interns and volunteers is very rewarding. SoHumane offers one high school junior the opportunity to intern and assist with all aspects of veterinary care in a shelter environment. For the past

fourteen months, we have had the pleasure to work with Hannah Smith, a student at Cascade Christian High School. She began her two-year internship in January 2019, and this spring will graduate and enter college with the goal of becoming a veterinarian. Mature, eager to learn and always a pleasure to work with, Hannah has been an invaluable addition to our vet care team. When asked what she will take away from her time at SoHumane, Hannah said, "Being an intern at SoHumane has been so amazing. I have learned more here than I could anywhere else. Because of this opportunity I am able to get hands-on experience in the veterinary field that will allow me to have a head start in my career. I have learned how to give subcutaneous and intravenous injections, prepare a surgical site, run tests on urine and fecal samples, restrain dogs and cats properly, and how spays, neuters, and other various surgeries are done. Having all of this experience will be a great asset for me in the future because I now have a strong knowledge base that will make learning much easier in college. I couldn't have asked for a better opportunity, and I am thankful every day that I get to come and really enjoy what I do."



Being a SoHumane vet care volunteer provides a unique hands-on opportunity to gain knowledge and understanding of the care provided for dogs and cats in a fast paced shelter environment. 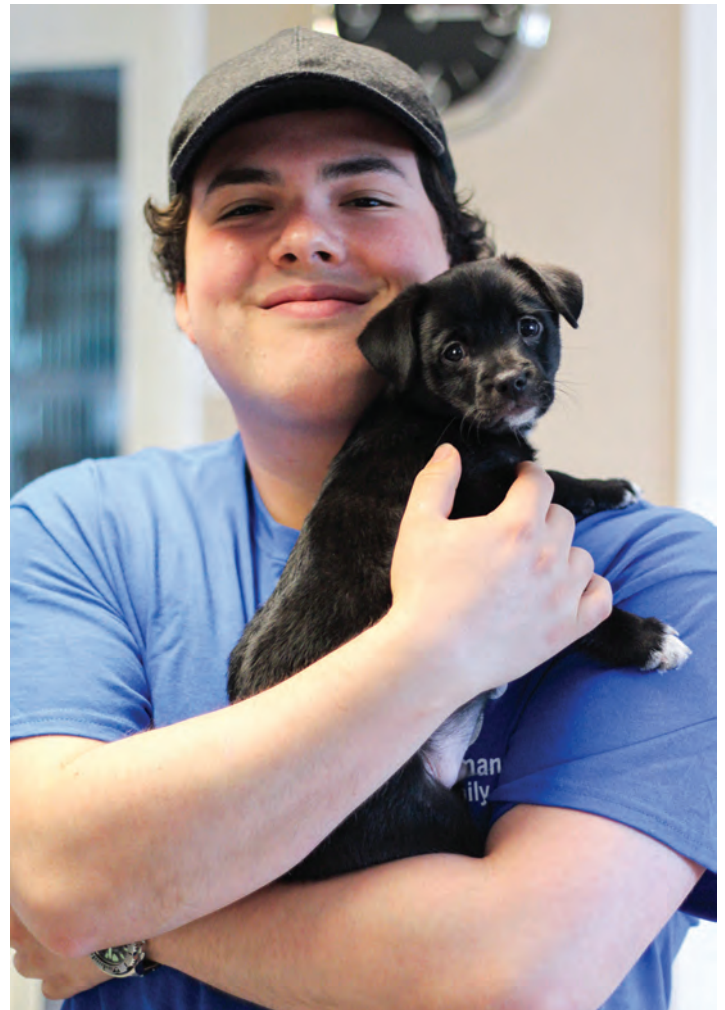
Fostering Brings Great Joy
